Duck Pond Assembly/Safety Rules

Assembly -

- 1. Select a level area to operate game with plenty of room to allow for a line to form. Keep a safe distance between player and the electrical cord and power source.
- 2. Place the steel base on a firm, level area.
- 3. Place the tub on top of the base.
- 4. Attach the skirting to the tub.
- 5. Insert the sign posts on either side of the tub, and slip the sign board in place.
- 6. Put a rubber duck onto the tops of both posts.
- 7. When taking down the game, do not fold skirting wet. Always dry thoroughly first.
- 8. If storing outside, leave the tub upside-down, so that rainwater does not collect inside.

Safety -

- 1. Before each use, inspect the power cord for any nicks or bad places in the insulation.
- 2. As always, use extreme caution when using electrical items near water.
- The pump is supplied with a grounding conductor. To reduce the risk of electrical shock, be certain that it is connected to a properly grounded grounding type receptacle. DO NOT REMOVE THE THIRD PRONG FROM THE PLUG.
- 4. Do not use an extension cord.
- 5. Be sure that the power cords run behind the unit and do not pose a triphazard.
- 6. Be sure to continually mop up any water that is splashed onto the floor, to avoid any slip hazard.
- 7. Do not pull the pump out of the water by its cord when the pump is operating or connected to the power source.
- 8. NEVER USE THE GAME IN STRONG WINDS OR LIGHTENING!!
- NEVER LEAVE THE TUB UNATTENDED WITH ANY AMOUNT OF WATER IN IT.
